
Service BC and Provincial Identity Information Management (IDIM) Program

• Service BC

- Counter, telephone and identity verification services BC citizens and businesses
- Key enablers: Payment (Pay BC), contact centre (phone, videochat, text), Digital Identity (BC Services Card/BCeID), Business Registry
- Allows for a significant improvement in efficiency and effective delivery
- Provincial Identity Information Management Program (IDIM) established in 2012 and joined Service BC December 2017
 - Mandate is to deliver secure and privacy-enhancing identity services for citizens and businesses to support access to multiple government services and information.
 - Both online and in-person solutions

3 functions

- CareCard replacement and reenrolment in MSP
- In person access to services
- On-line access to services





BC Services Card Mobile Video Chat


Increase convenience for citizens to access online services securely using their mobile devices
